

APOSTLE LORRAINE THORNHILL FEATURED SPEAKER

In 1997, Rev. Lorraine A. Thornhill became the first female Pastor of the Kingdom Empowerment Center (formerly First Holiness Church) in Cambridge, MA. Prior to her becoming a pastor she worked for seven years as a Psychotherapist and Minority Liaison for Bentley College in Waltham, MA.

Rev. Thornhill is actively involved beyond the walls of the church. She is the President of the Cambridge Black Pastors Alliance, Chaplain for the Cambridge Police Department, Board member for the Cambridge Community Foundation, and a Commissioner for the City of Cambridge's Human Service Department. She has also served on the board of Safe Havens Interfaith Partnership Against Domestic Violence, and former board presidents of Cambridge YWCA & Cambridge Cares about Aids.

Rev. Thornhill identifies with the prophet Isaiah in that she too has been anointed and appointed by God to bring good news to the oppressed, to comfort the broken-hearted and to set those who are bound free.

Rev. Thornhill is also the Founder and President of Higher Heights LLC, and a certified Mental Health First Aid Instructor. Her life's purpose is to be a conduit

for God by being a woman of wisdom that speaks life, truth, and destiny into people.
